We know that many of you have clogged at the Georgia Mountain Fairgrounds. We bring clogging back to this nostalgic location. This 1-day competition will be Saturday, October 2, 2021.

<u>Location:</u> The competition will be held at Anderson Music Hall, Georgia Mountain Fairgrounds, 1311 Music Road, Hiawassee, GA 30546

The event will be held in the 2,900 seat climate controlled venue. GA Mountain Fairgrounds hosts popular events such as: GA Mountain Fair, Superstar Concert Series, GA Mountain Fall Festival and GA's State Fiddlers' Convention. Located on Lake Chatuge in the north GA mountain community of Hiawassee, only two hours from Atlanta, Greenville, Asheville and Chattanooga. The Fairgrounds offer year-round camping facilities.



Labor Day Weekend - Nashville, Tennessee

This event is a qualifying event for the 2021-2022 USA National Championships held Labor Day Weekend at the Gaylord Opryland Hotel. Any team placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the category is qualified to attend the Championships. For additional information, please email: Clog@clog.org.

Skill Levels

- 1. Recreational Level Teams: (This level is designed for true beginner dancers to gain experience in competition. Dancers should have less than 2 years of clogging experience. Use of Basic Clogging Steps and Workshop style routines are encouraged but not limited to the dancers level. Must wear clogging shoes. Coordinated outfits where appropriate are encouraged. This is a non-sanctioned, non-qualified level for USA National Championships. Knowledge of the rules is expected. This level will provide a learning opportunity for teams that are new to competition.
- 2. Amateur Level Teams/Duets: Contestants with less competition experience. Amateur Level Teams must NOT consist of more than 30% of Masters Level Dancers.
- 3. Masters Level Teams/Duets: Contestants with extensive competition experience.
- 4. Contestants and/or Directors will determine dancer's level.
- 5. An Amateur Level Dancer, Duo/Duet or Team may dance in the Masters Level category, but a Masters Level Dancer, Duo/Duet or Team may NOT dance in a Amateur Level category.
- 6. If amateur and masters levels are offered, BOTH levels will be sanctioned.
- 7. **Masters Individuals**: ANY individual may dance here regardless of previous awards.
- 8. Amateur Individuals: ONLY those individuals who NEVER placed 1st in any competition in the age division awarded previously to this competition are eligible to dance as Amateur. (Ex: Won 1st in 5-7, now 8-10, OK)

Acapella Duet: (Non-Sanctioned)

Time Limit - 1 Minute

Levels: Challenge and Masters (see guidelines)

Dancers: 1 couple – male/male, female/female or male/female.

Costumes: No requirements

Figures: Figures are allowed, but not required

Steps: Any Clog steps allowed. Dancers must be in step with each other at

all times.

Handclaps are NOT allowed.

Movement: Dance must start from and end on stage, no dancing on/off stage.

Music: No music allowed.

Callers: Dance may NOT be called, cued or heard.

Judging: Judges face away from stage and judge the clarity and intricacy of

performance.

Choreographed Solos: (Non-Sanctioned)Time limit is 1 ½ minutes

Costumes: No requirements

Steps: Any clogging steps are allowed.

Judging: Emphasis will be on sound, rhythm and entertainment value.

Music: Any type of music is allowed.

Dancers: Males and Females will compete against each other.

Movement: Dancer must use entire stage showing the ability to move with pre-

cision footwork.

Props: Stage props are allowed but MUST BE INCORPORATED into the

choreography of the routine.

To determine team's and/or duet's average age — total the ages of all dancers performing in that particular routine, then divide that number by the total number of dancers. (Example: If average age is 15.8, the age division you would then dance in would be Junior.)


Individuals: 4 & under, 5-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-19, 20-29, 30-49, 50 & over

Acapella Individuals: 12 & under and 13 & over (One Level Only) Short Duets: 12 & under, and 13 & over (One Level Only)

We reserve the right to combine or sub-divide age divisions depending on number of entrees received. Scores will be sent to NCHC based on Ages as indicated above.

Scoresheets: Will be available for pickup at the end of the competition, Scoresheets not picked up will be scanned and emailed to team directors.
